# Reading/Language

- <u>Reading</u>: Students will begin reading our first chapter book: <u>Loser</u> by Jerry Spinelli. We will be reviewing character traits and motivations again this week. There will be a reading test on Friday. See the study guide for vocabulary words and reading skill information. Fluency questions (fluency folder) are due Friday.

<u>- Language</u>: There will be a spelling/word work test on Thursday. See the study guide for spelling words and word work information.

# Science/Health

 We will be doing a mystery science experiment involving chain reactions. We will also study sound energy and finish our study guide from last week. We will take a Chapter 1 Lesson 2 Sound Energy Test Friday. There will be no homework. I will have an optional extra credit assignment to take a picture of a chain reaction the student creates. This will be due Tuesday, Sept. 4.

### Math

- This week, we will continue to practice rounding large numbers. We will also start adding and subtracting numbers up to the hundred thousand's place with and without regrouping.

- We will have a multiplication fluency Quiz Thursday covering the 3's and 4's facts. Please encourage your children to practice their facts as often as possible! I have been giving them extra time but will gradually start decreasing the time on the timed tests to where they only have 3 seconds per problem.
