

CAR LINE REMINDERS

As we start a new school year, we would like to remind our parents of a few things when participating in car line.

- Make sure your child knows his/her car line number. Practice, practice, practice!
- Do not get out of your car in car line. The school staff and safety patrol will help your child find his/her car.
- You must have your official car rider tag posted in the window for your number to be called. If you do not have the number posted, you will be asked to park and walk in to get your child. You will present your identification to the school secretary.
- Car line begins at 7:15 in the morning and all students must be picked up by 3:10 in the afternoon. Pre-K students should not be dropped off until 7:30.
- In the afternoon, car line should start at the stop sign at the bottom of the hill. The first car is allowed to pull up to the school at 2:35. This is necessary for visitors and emergency vehicles to have access to the front entrance of the school.
- Students should be dropped off in car line only, not the parking lot.
- Students should enter and exit the passenger side of the car. For the afternoon, this door is the sign that all cars have been loaded.
- Students should be trained to buckle and unbuckle their own seatbelt. You will need to park in the parking lot if he/she needs assistance with buckling.
- In the afternoon, make sure you fill up both lines and follow the directions of the staff.
- In the morning, make sure your children are ready—unbuckled, backpacks on—to get out of the car when you pull up to the school.
- The tardy bell rings at 7:45. After this time, you will be required to come inside and sign in your child in the office.
