Reading/Language

- Reading- We will continue reading our chapter book, Loser. We will have a test Friday on chapters 8-13. The test will cover main idea, questions from ch. 8-13, and vocabulary from those chapters. Fluency questions are due on Friday.

<u>Language:</u> Spelling and Word Work test will be on Thursday.

Science/Social Studies

- <u>Science</u>: We will be finishing up our unit on energy this week. We will have a Chapter 1, Lessons 3-4 Light and Heat Test on Tuesday. We will spend the rest of the week doing Mystery Science experiments on sound energy. There will be no new homework this week.
- <u>Social Studies:</u> We will be studying Prehistoric Alabama in our Week 2 newsletter this week. The students will be making a Dinosaur flip book on Thursday and take an Assessment on Friday.

Math

- This week, we will continue adding and subtracting numbers up to the hundred thousand's place (with and without regrouping) and continue solving word problems with addition and subtraction. We will also start learning about multiplication using expanded form.
- We will have a multiplication fluency Quiz covering the 3's and 4's facts again. (I decided to give them more time to practice.) Please encourage your children to practice their facts as often as possible! They should each have flash cards and a practice fluency sheet covering the 3's and 4's facts.
