Reading/Language

- **Reading**- This week, we will continue reading our chapter book, Loser. There will not be a reading test this week. We will cover Main Idea and continue vocabulary and comprehension from chapters 8-13. Fluency questions are due on Fridays.

- **Language**- Spelling and word work test will be Friday.

Science/Social Studies

- For Science, we will be doing Mystery Science experiments this week having to do with sound waves. On Tuesday, 4H will come out to introduce their club and curriculum to our students. There will be no homework in Science this week.

- For Social Studies, we will extend our understanding of AL's 5 regions and emergence of settlers to the area in the early 1800s by reading primary source articles and designing postage stamps as well as creating a play-doh model of the 5 regions. There will be no homework in Social Studies this week.

Math

- This week, we will continue adding and subtracting numbers up to the hundred thousand's place (with and without regrouping). We will also practice solving word problems with addition and subtraction.

- We will have a multiplication fluency Quiz Thursday or Friday covering the 3's and 4's facts again. Please encourage your children to practice their facts as often as possible! These quizzes are negatively affecting grades for the students who are not fluent with their facts.
